Amber International School, established in 2005, affiliation with CBSE (code: 1130640), provides education from Nursery to Grade 12 The school located in Dhokali , Thane west offers plethora of subject options in streams of Science, Commerce & Humanities

The name of the school was changed from **Dnyan Sadhana Vidya Niketan** to **Amber International School** in March, 2021.Over a period of 3 academic years i.e. from 2020-21 to 2022-23, Amber International School has shown remarkable growth. Strength of students has increased from 651 to 2000 students over a period of three years.

Whereas teacher strength has grown from 24 to 90 .The admin staff has gone up from 3 to 10, the security, support and supervision staff has raised from 12 to 26 in number.

GRADE X ACHIEVERS 2022-23

In Grade X, total 101 students appeared for the CBSE Board examination and we are glad to announce that in Grade X we got 100% results.

Out of 101 students, 79 students got first division. Ms. Bhavna Vipin is the school topper with 97.40 % marks.

Out of 249 students of Grade 12, who appeared for the AISSCE Examination , 24 students of all the three streams, secured 90% and above.
